



Called:

*“You did not choose Me, but **I chose you** and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give you.”*

John 10:12-13

Called Before Hired

Hired:

“But a hireling, he who is not the shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; and the wolf catches the sheep and scatters them.


The hireling flees because he is a hireling and does not care about the sheep.”

John 10: 12-13

Teachers who change the world are called, not hired.

Crossing the Street on Race



*“Then the woman of Samaria said to [Jesus], ‘How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman? For Jews have **no dealings with Samaritans.**’”*

John 4:9

Crossing the Street on Race

Jesus:

*“It is not good to take the children’s bread and throw it to the **little dogs**.”*

Canaanite woman:

*“**Yes, Lord, yet** even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their master’s table.”*

Matthew 15:22-28

Crossing the Street on Race

Jesus's litmus test on race relations:

*“Love the Lord your **God** with all your heart, with all your soul, and all your mind” and “love your **neighbor** as **yourself**.”*

Matthew 22:37b and 39b
